EDWARD MCGLYNN GAFFNEY, JR., is a professor of law at Valparaiso University, where he served for seven years as its dean. He teaches constitutional law and constitutional history, and served as the Director of Content at the National Constitution Center, a new interactive museum that will open in Philadelphia on July 4, 2003. He was an academic consultant and a signer of the Williamsburg Charter, a bicentennial celebration of religious freedom in 1989. He has served on the Board of Editors of the *Journal of Law and Religion*, and has recently co-edited with Circuit Judge John T. Noonan, Jr. a collection of historical materials and cases on religious freedom. He has taught at Notre Dame Law School and Loyola Law School (Los Angeles), and is now in post-production of "Empty Boxcars," a documentary film on the rescue of the Jews of Bulgaria in 1943 and the murder of the Jews of Thrace and Macedonia in the same year.
