BOB STERN is President of the Center for Governmental Studies, a Los Angeles based non-profit organization that studies the initiative process, campaign financing, electronic filing of campaign statements, and judicial elections. He co-authored Democracy by Initiative: Shaping California's Fourth Branch of Government, a 464-page book examining California's initiative process, which was published by the Center in 1992. Before coming to the Center, he was general counsel for the California Fair Political Practices Commission, the state agency in charge of administering and enforcing the state's campaign finance, conflicts of interest, and lobbying laws. He was the principal co-author of the Political Reform Act of 1974, an initiative measure (Proposition 9) passed by 70% of the state's voters.
